Clever shopping



Assessment criteria

Students will score 5 if they complete their two chosen tasks accurately and they clearly communicate the concepts involved in clever shopping. A score of 5+ is reserved for students who exceed the standard expected in stage 4.

2	Makes some progress with the tasks. There is limited understanding of the key mathematical ideas or the conceptual ideas.	Minimal evidence of planning and limited communication/reasoning.
