

**Questions and Planning to form your
Historical Inquiry**

Vietnam War

Your Task:

Create a timeline of the key events of the Vietnam War.

Your timeline should also investigate the reasons for the Vietnam War (how and why it started) and how it ended (including relevant events that followed after the Vietnam War).

You must also research and communicate the events that are relevant to Australia's involvement in this war.

Considerations:

- ⇒ Generate questions that will inform your historical inquiry.
- ⇒ Identify and locate a range of relevant sources.
- ⇒ Locate information that is related to your inquiry questions.
- ⇒ Organise research into sections/ or by using own methods (which demonstrate a clear, structured process)
- ⇒ Write notes and present final information in your own words.
- ⇒ Compare information and take different perspectives/points of view into consideration.
- ⇒ Present timeline on a piece of A3 card (or larger if agreed upon by classroom teacher).
- ⇒ Information presented should be accurate and in order.
- ⇒ Include photographs/maps/visual aids that are relevant to your information.
